Busajo is a program that serves children living on the streets of Soddo.

One of the two directors meets with children on the streets to get to know them, tell them about the program and to assess the child's seriousness to be educated and to have a different life. After three months of getting to know the children on the street, if they are seriously interested, they are invited to start to attend classes every day. The

children will go to school, receive clothing, food, school supplies, shelter, love and medical and psychological attention and care. Busajo does their very best to reunify the children with their families and they are successful about 85% of the time. Sometimes the family only needs financial assistance to repair a damaged home or to provide a cow in order to take their child back. The children that cannot be reunified with their families remain in the program and receive education and skills training.
